## Parade Float Suggestions:

- Use a festive banner.
- Have participants walking and handing out candy, flyers, balloons, stickers, etc.
- Decorate a vehicle with temporary paint (or glass chalk) to display your group's name.
- Use a pickup truck or wagon and pull a trailer with display (proper float).
- Use golf carts, go-carts, tractors, four-wheelers, bicycles, etc...
- Dogs (with leashes) and horses allowed. **You are responsible for cleanup.**
- Walk with a creative sign.
- Incorporate a Blue & White Bighorn theme.
- Rollerblade, skateboard, or cycle with your float (safety equipment required).

## Incorporating your group's activities:

- If you are a sports club, wear your team's jerseys or make your entry designed with things from your sport.
- Give a performance related to your group.
- Wear your group's t-shirt and walk behind a festive banner.

# 2022 LPHS Homecoming Parade Entry Rules

## Rules for the Parade:

1. Entry forms are due by 4:00pm on October 4th.
2. Please drop off entries to the main office at the high school or email them to [mmitchem@bssd72.org](mailto:mmitchem@bssd72.org)
2. Groups will be responsible for setup, participation during the parade, and teardown/cleanup immediately after the parade.
3. No reference to alcohol, drugs, or use of derogatory language will be permitted. If references occur the entry will be disqualified and removed from the parade at the discretion of parade officials or administrators.
4. The Parade Committee will inspect the floats immediately prior to the parade start at 6:00pm. They will check that the floats are safe and appropriate for the parade. Safety concerns include structural integrity and staying within the building parameters in rule five.
5. No float can be taller than 10 feet from the ground up and no wider than 8 feet 8 inches. Please call if your float is bigger than this; exceptions can be made.
6. All entries must have at least one supervising adult along during the entire parade route.
7. Once your entry has started along the parade route, no one may board your float.
8. Adult drivers, 21 years of age and older, ONLY. No student drivers.
9. Your entry may not exit the parade route before the end of the parade.
10. For public safety, nothing may be thrown from your entry. Candy/flyers/small gifts may be HANDED out along the parade route.
